

## EVENING DRESS OF THE EARLY JAZZ AGE

Fig. 3289-9290. Frock of satin; the skirt has the front and back beaded and hem in Turkish finish; the bodice is hung over a band of tinsel lace; shoulder straps of velvet ribbon and bead buckles. Material required : 5 yards 40 inches wide, 1 ¼ yards of 12 inches wide.



Fig. 3291D Frock of taffeta: the scalloped hem is self bound and hangs beneath the full over skirt of silk net; the latter has the crinoline effect heightened by a band of ostrich feathers; taffeta bodice has sequin epaulettes and front impiecement. Material required; 3 ½ yards of taffeta 36 inches wide, 2 ¾ yards;; of net 46 inches wide.

Fig. 3293D. Evening dress indicating a foundation of novelty lace topped by a Greek drapery effect, of silk marquisette arranged in semi-princess suggestion; girdle of velvet ribbon adorned with miniature roses. Material required: 3 ½ yards of lace 42 inches wide, 354. yards of marquisette; 40 inches wide.
